Retinal Photography

Highly sophisticated, computerized camera enables us to provide a more thorough retinal analysis of your eyes. Retinal photography can assist in documentation of retinal problems such as retinal detachment, holes, thinning, optic nerve disease, pre-cancerous lesions, macular degeneration, hypertensive retinopathy and diabetic retinopathy, to name just a few.

The purpose of this procedure is similar to that of an x-ray taken by your dentist. Photo-documentation is painless and usually does not require eye dilation. In addition nothing will touch your eye. The photos will last forever or as long as you are a patient. This can be an excellent reference point from which your doctor can make future comparisons.

We recommend that all patients receive this test. It is especially important for all people over 35 as well as for those patients who have a history of high blood pressure, diabetes, retinal problems, headaches, floaters, flashing lightstreaks, or a strong prescription for glasses.
